Reminders from the lunch clerk

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Harmony Public Schools strives each day to provide a safe, caring, and collaborative atmosphere for our students. Nutritious meals are available daily for a price of \$1.50 for breakfast, \$3.00 for lunch, and \$0.50 for a la carte milk.

Each student is provided a lunch account onto which money may be deposited. Deposits may be made online by going to www.schoolcafe.com and creating a parent account. Through School Café, you may also set up low balance alerts and automatic payments. Deposits may also be made by money order or credit/debit card at the school office.

If you would like to apply for free or reduced price meals, the lunch application is available online at www.schoolcafe.com. A paper copy of the application is also available at the school office. Note that just a milk costs \$0.50, regardless of eligibility. If your child is later approved for free or reduced price meals, the negative balance still must be paid. Please find your child's lunch account balance below. You may pay it in full or contact the school to set up a payment plan.

Students with balances exceeding the district limit of \$-15.00 will receive an alternate meal. Breakfast will include cereal, fruit, and milk. Lunch will include a sandwich, vegetable, and milk.
