Reminders from the Medical aide

Dear parents or guardian,

There has been an outbreak of head lice here at the school. Please do not be alarmed, as this is a common occurrence in schools.

Please take these precautions:

1. Check your child's hair for eggs (also called nits)
2. If you suspect your child has head lice, ask your health care provider to diagnose the problem.
3. If head lice is diagnosed, DO NOT send your child to school until ALL nits are removed. Lice Shampoo alone will not solve the problem. REMEMBER WE HAVE A NO NIT POLICY. As long as your child continues to have nits(eggs) they will be sent home until their hair is nit free.

Remember that you must keep checking your child's hair for new nits every day for at least 3 weeks if diagnosed and periodically thereafter.

HEALTH NOTICE TO PARENTS

The peak of the cold and flu season is upon us. To prevent the widespread of flu in the school, we recommend that your child stay home from school if experiencing cold or flu symptoms and stomach issues. Remember colds are the most contagious during the first 24 hours. Your child should be physically able to participate in all school activities. Keeping a sick child at home will minimize the spread of infections and viruses in the classroom.

Reminders from the lunch clerk

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Harmony Public Schools strives each day to provide a safe, caring, and collaborative atmosphere for our students. Nutritious meals are available daily for a price of \$1.50 for breakfast, \$3.00 for lunch, and \$0.50 for a la carte milk.

Each student is provided a lunch account onto which money may be deposited. Deposits may be made online by going to www.schoolcafe.com and creating a parent account. Through School Café, you may also set up low balance alerts and automatic payments. Deposits may also be made by money order or credit/debit card at the school office.

If you would like to apply for free or reduced price meals, the lunch application is available online at www.schoolcafe.com. A paper copy of the application is also available at the school office. Note that just a milk costs \$0.50, regardless of eligibility. If your child is later approved for free or reduced price meals, the negative balance still must be paid.

Please find your child's lunch account balance below. You may pay it in full or contact the school to set up a payment plan.

Students with balances exceeding the district limit of \$-15.00 will receive an alternate meal. Breakfast will include cereal, fruit, and milk.

Lunch will include a sandwich, vegetable, and milk.
