Priority Deadline: January 15



Basic Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for a TEXAS Grant award, a student must:

- Be classified by the institution as a Texas resident
- Be registered with Selective Service, or be exempt
- Have financial need, as determined by the institution
- Be enrolled at least 3/4 time
- Not have earned a baccalaureate degree
- Not have been convicted of a felony or crime involving a controlled substance
- Enroll via one of the pathways: High School, Associate Degree, Military, and Transfer Pathways.

Initial award priority consideration is given to:

- ✓ High School Graduation Pathway
- ✓ Meeting Basic Eligibility Requirements
- ✓ Application for Financial Aid by **January 15**
- ✓ Meeting at least **2** of the following **4** areas:

- **Advanced Academic Program** – 12 hours of college credit (dual credit or AP courses), complete the Distinguished Achievement Program
- **TSI Readiness** – Meet the Texas Success Initiative assessment thresholds or qualify for an exemption
- **Class Standing** – Graduate in the top 1/3 of the HS graduating class or have a B average on a 4.0 grading scale
- **Advanced Math** – Complete at least one math course beyond Algebra II

Recommended Timeline



- Priority is given to students who apply by the January 15 priority deadline. Check with your institution on specific submission requirements.
- The financial aid office at your institution will determine your eligibility for this program and notify you if you are eligible.
